



### M.A.C Select Moisturecover Concealer

\$36

**KT:** This dual-tipped concealer has two colours – yellow and coral – which you can blend for a customised shade.

Start by using the yellow to cover up dark eye circles or scars with blue undertones. Then use the coral shade to adjust the coverage so that it blends with your skin tone. Not for amateurs.

**DO:** This is budge-proof and gives medium to full coverage. It is good for masking both age spots and acne.



### The Balm Liquid Timebalm Spot Concealer

\$32.90, from Sasa

**KT:** I like how this concealer contains tea tree oil to combat pimples while covering them up effectively.

But I would not recommend this for the under-eye area as the tea tree oil may sting sensitive eyes.

**DO:** It has a faint medicated smell because it contains tea tree oil. It is not suitable for the delicate under-eye area as it does not spread easily.



### Shiseido Makeup Natural Finish Cream Concealer

**KT:** This cream concealer blends well into my skin so that scars, blemishes and eyebags fade out of sight.

Good for those who want more coverage that does not cake on the skin.

**DO:** This is great for keeping acne scars and pimples out of sight. It also reduces the appearance of pores and fine lines.



### Clarins Instant Light Brush On Perfector

**KT:** I like the rosy undertones of this concealer, which brighten up my complexion. This is great if you need only light coverage.

**DO:** It is extremely easy to use, thanks to its brush applicator, as you don't have to get your fingers dirty.

It has a light texture and can double as a highlighter.

**KT:** This is a great drugstore find that works wonders at masking all sorts of flaws, from spots to dark eye circles.

It blends effortlessly into the skin for a barely there finish.

**DO:** This rich formula requires a light touch as a little goes a long way. I like the porcelain, poreless finish it delivers.



### Rimmel Stay Matte Dual Action Concealer

**KT:** Those who have oily skin will appreciate this formula as it delivers a non-shiny finish.

**DO:** It does not blend easily but delivers a very matte finish that takes away the redness of angry spots.



### Lancome Teint Miracle Bare Skin Perfecting Correcting Pen

**KT:** Not only does this conceal my puffy eyes, it also gives my skin a glow, which makes me look well-rested even when I'm not.

**DO:** This pen concealer spreads well and moisturises my skin. It does not cover my under-eye circles completely but makes up for it with a natural finish.



### Estee Lauder Double Wear Stay-In-Place Concealer

**KT:** The liquid texture makes this easy to spread over spots and dark eye circles.

Once it dries up, it stays put until I clean it off with make-up remover.

**DO:** This helps to fake eight hours of sleep. It offers medium coverage for dark spots and under-eye circles. True to its name, it stays put even past office hours.
